CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following guidelines have been set in place in the interests of health and safety.

- All vehicles operating on the Reserve must be registered and the operators suitably licensed. This is a public reserve and the Traffic Act applies.
- A speed limit of 5 km applies within the Reserve to keep dust at a minimum.
- Gate 1 only is to be used by sporting bodies for entry and exit to the Rodeo arena, Gate 2 may be used for paying events and Gate 3 is designated for the use of caravans booking into the park.
- Only committee members of the various clubs to park in the area along from the caravan park office & up to time event chute. All floats and trucks to park along the Stuart Highway side of the arena. All spectators /visitors must utilise the carpark outside.
- Polocrosse to enter at Gate 4. Prior to polocrosse carnivals the President or committee member should liaise with the Groundsman re parking of floats and goosenecks etc.
- No parking on grassed areas outside main office demountable and grassed area behind sponsor's box near arena.
- Prior to groups wishing to use the Reserve a courtesy call to the groundsman / manager is required. The Reserve is available generally Mon. to Wed. until 6.30 pm. Thurs. and Fri. are for arena preparation. Please ensure your members are aware of this.
- The campdraft arena and No. 3 Polocrosse field can be utilised for training prior to competitions. Again check if convenient with the Groundsman as mowing and irrigating takes place on a regular basis on the polocrosse fields and campdraft arena.
- Horses are not to be ridden or walked on the mounds around the rodeo arena.
- Glass is strictly prohibited on any part of the grounds.
- Dogs must be tied up or on a lead at all times.
- All rubbish to be placed in the bins provided or skip bins. For larger events extra bins may need to be ordered by the relevant user group.
- Wash down bays, taps and hoses are located on the grounds.
- HOWEVER no irrigation is to be disconnected and hoses not to be removed.
- Horse manure is to be removed from any of the allocated caravan sites.
- Baling twine must be removed from the grounds.
- Wheelbarrows and rakes can be supplied and manure can be distributed along the treeline of the highway fence.
- The toilets will be handed over in a clean manner. Toilets are to be cleaned by each user group and maintained during their event.
- All cattle coming onto the Reserve must be accompanied by the relevant way bill and be scanned with a reading wand prior to unloading.
